## OVERVIEW

Students will stay in three of the world's most vibrant and diverse cities, **Santiago, Chile; Montevideo, Uruguay; and Buenos Aires, Argentina**. As the birthplace of distinguished poets such as Gabriela Mistral and Pablo Neruda (both winners of the Nobel Prize in Literature), Delmira Agustini, and Jorge Luis Borges, these cosmopolitan cities offer everything. This intensive program allows students to study and meet personally several Latin American authors and artists, improve their Spanish language skills, and earn 6 credit hours of upper-level Spanish.

- Open to all majors
- Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA at the time of application and until program start
- Must be in Good Academic and Conduct Standing with Texas A&M University
- Must attend all pre-departure meetings
- Must have completed SPAN 202 by program start or have obtained approval of the faculty leader
- Faculty approval

## ACADEMICS INFO

All students are required to take a total of **6 credit hours of program courses** to participate on this program. Students should meet with their academic advisors to ensure they meet eligibility requirements and that the courses are degree applicable. **\*\*There is a required Spring semester pre-departure orientation class (HISP 250 - 1 credit)**

## ACTIVITIES

Excursions to Chilean towns and cities such as Valparaiso, Vina del Mar, Algarrobo, and Isla Negra; experience beautiful vineyards, theaters, and museums; learn about Pablo Neruda; excursions to Uruguayan cities such as Pinta del Este and Colonia del Sacramento; long excursion to Buenos Aires.
