DEGREE OVERVIEW

Philosophers have long asked key questions, evaluated possibilities and arrived at those answers that have shaped and reshaped who we are, how we do things, and how we understand the world in which we live. The study of philosophy transforms intellectual curiosity into a potent, flexible set of skills by cultivating the ability to identify unstated assumptions, to take a critical attitude toward the information that others accept, and to evaluate and articulate the reasons that compel us to do and believe things. In addition to history and logic, students are free to select among a range of courses that allow them to better understand the limits of knowledge, the limits of scientific thinking, the theories behind our legal and political system, the foundations of ethics and more.

Nationally, philosophy majors score near the top in entrance exams for graduate and professional schools, including the GRE, LSAT and GMAT. They also boast high salary growth and strong mid-career salaries.




UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH
