#### **Grant Guidelines**

Each semester, the Department of History will offer a limited number of Study Abroad Grants (\$750 for trips lasting up to 5-weeks; \$1,000 for 10-week trips; \$1,250 for semester or longer experiences). These competitive grants are designed to support undergraduate history majors and minors undertaking study abroad experiences and other students who enroll in study abroad programs led by history department faculty members. Upon their return, students who are awarded a Study Abroad Grant are required to submit a one-page report detailing their use of the grant money and also to give a short presentation on their experience to other history majors interested in study abroad. Students interested in a Study Abroad Grant should submit: 1) a completed application (click here), and; 2) a letter of recommendation from a history faculty member supporting their application. Each year, the Department of History Undergraduate Committee will review applications in **October** for trips in the upcoming spring semester, in **February** for summer trips, and in **March** for trips in the subsequent fall semester.
